
<u>Prof. Nirmal Kumar Ganguly</u> Biotechnology Research Professor, National Institute of Immunology, New Delhi President, JIPMER, Pondicherry Former Director General, ICMR



Prof. Nirmal Kumar Ganguly is a Distinguished Biotechnology Research Professor at the National Institute of Immunology, New Delhi. He is also President of the Jawaharlal Institute of Post Graduate Medical Education and Research, Pondicherry. He is former Director General of the Indian Council of Medical Research. His major research areas include Tropical Diseases, Cardiovascular Diseases, and Diarrheal Diseases. His area of expertise is Infectious Diseases. His interests encompass the disciplines of Immunology, Biotechnology and Public Health. He is Fellow of all the Indian National Science Academies. He is also Fellow of several international organizations, including the Royal College of Pathologists (London), the Imperial College Faculty of Medicine (London), the Third World Academy of Sciences (Italy), and the International Academy of Cardiovascular Sciences (Canada).

Prof. Ganguly has won numerous national and international awards and received the prestigious Padma Bhushan Award in Medicine. He has made important contributions to the field of rheumatic fever and rheumatic heart disease and their public health aspects and pathogenesis. His other contributions include research on the immunological roots of Coronary Artery Disease (CAD) and pathogenesis of Takayasu's Disease. Dr. Ganguly obtained his MBBS from the University of Calcutta, received his MD from the Postgraduate Institute of Medical Education & Research, Chandigarh, and obtained honorary D.Sc. from several Indian Universities. Dr. Ganguly has published over 750 original research papers and mentored over 100 Ph.D theses.
